ABOUT THIS EVENT

For the past 30 years, women in the United States have earned more bachelor and master degrees than men, and women-owned businesses are growing at a 1.5x faster rate than all other firms. Women-owned businesses are generating \$1.3 trillion in revenues annually, and the value continues to rise; revenues were up 59% in the U.S. between 1997 and 2013. On top of that, women entrepreneurs in the U.S. are much more engaged in the innovation sector, with 36% of female business owners delivering innovative products and services, compared to 17% of men. In spite of these developments start-ups are still mostly founded by men.

Prof. Fisher will discuss why this is so, what skills are necessary to overcome existing obstacles, what role factors such as work-life balance play, what experiences female entrepreneurs have made in the start-up culture in the United States and what their future might be like in the new digital workforce.
